"better-run studies assessing short and medium term risks, found no major causes of concern associated with vaping"

"in stop smoking services in 2020 to 2021, quit attempts involving a vaping product were associated with the highest success rates (64.9% compared with 58.6% for attempts not involving a vaping product)"

"Based on the reviewed evidence, we believe that the 'at least 95% less harmful' estimate remains broadly accurate, at least over short term and medium term periods."
